

Ruhr University Bochum (Ruhr-Universität Bochum, RUB) is one of Germany's leading research universities. As a reform-oriented campus university, we are unique in that we combine the full spectrum of major scientific fields under one roof. Dynamic interactions between the various subjects and academic disciplines offer excellent opportunities for interdisciplinary collaboration for researchers and students alike.

The Universitätsklinikum der Ruhr-Universität Bochum (UK RUB) comprises qualified hospitals and specialist medical facilities in the Bochum, Herne and Ostwestfalen-Lippe region which cooperate with the Ruhr University. UK RUB stands for exceptional medical care as well as for outstanding research and teaching in the field of university medicine.

The Faculty of Medicine at Ruhr University Bochum has an opening in the Clinic for Plastic Surgery and Hand Surgery, Severe Burn Centre, Sarcoma Centre at BG Universitätsklinikum Bergmannsheil:

Junior professorship (equivalent to paygrade W1) with later tenure-track appointment (equivalent to paygrade W2) for modern reconstructive hand surgery and rehabilitation

The successful candidate will represent the Plastic Surgery and Hand Surgery discipline in research and teaching and is expected to conduct comprehensive scientific work in the field of hand surgery. This includes reappraising the following subject areas: endoprosthetics, infections, tendon surgery, tumour surgery and rehabilitation.

This is a fixed-term position with a duration of three years; after a positive interim evaluation, the position will be extended for a further three years. The vacancy is connected to a tenure-track appointment to an associate professorship (equivalent to paygrade W2). Based on a positive evaluation, the successful candidate will be appointed to an associate professorship in an appropriate, simplified appointment procedure, without the position being reposted. For information on the specific evaluation criteria for the professorship, please contact the Dean's Office.

This position requires an outstanding doctorate as well as proof of the candidate's particular aptitude for academic teaching and willingness to participate in academic self-administration. Candidates must meet appointment requirements in accordance with section 36 ff of the Higher Education Act for North Rhine-Westphalia (Hochschulgesetz NW).

Further requirements are:

- a high level of commitment to teaching;
- the willingness to perform interdisciplinary scientific work;
- the willingness and ability to acquire externally funded research projects;

The successful candidate is expected to strive to become a specialist for plastic, reconstructive and aesthetic surgery, followed by an additional qualification as a hand surgeon.

The successful candidate will be expected to integrate into the faculty's principal research areas (oncology, neurosciences and protein sciences).

Ideally, the successful candidate will also collaborate at scientific and clinical level with the facilities of the Faculty of Medicine and UK RUB in the current main areas of research and participate in existing and future collaborative research projects.

Ruhr University Bochum and BG Universitätsklinikum Bergmannsheil stand for diversity and equal opportunities. We therefore foster collaboration between diverse teams and promote the careers of those who are under-represented in their respective fields. RUB expressly welcomes applications from women. In fields in which they are under-represented, they will be given preference where qualifications are equivalent. We also welcome applications from persons with disabilities.
