Rotation Requirements

- At the time of your application you will have to prove a language level of German B2 (according to the CEFRL or comparable proof)
- The minimum rotation per department is two weeks except for the Department of Psychiatry, which requires a minimum four weeks
- Places for clinical trainees will be allocated according to free capacities in one of our university clinics.

Duration of Stay

We strongly recommend that you make the length of your stay generous. After your last rotation day, you will need a few days to complete your paperwork, especially to obtain the necessary certificates from your successfully completed clinical rotations to issue your Transcript of Records.

ECTS-Credits & Learning Agreement

One week's traineeship (five working days) is awarded with 1.25 Credit Points. ECTS credits are NOT awarded for rotations unless you are with us under the Erasmus+ program (or others) AND your university is a cooperation partner. Nevertheless, our clinics will provide you with a certificate after your clinical rotation. If you have a Learning Agreement that needs to be signed at the end of your stay, these certificates will have to be send to international-medizin@rub.de along with the Learning Agreement.

International Office

For all non-faculty related questions please visit the website of our <u>International Office</u>. Please note that our International Office also offers students who come to us for an internship the opportunity to enroll at the Ruhr-Universität Bochum.

A social contribution of around 330€ per semester would have to be paid - student ticket throughout North Rhine-Westphalia and Mensa card included (useful for university canteens and cafeterias, as you get a student discount).

Housing
